## Re: End of Year Exams

As we move through the summer term students will sit end-of-year examinations. The purpose is to assess student progress, identify where students might need support in the future and provide students with the experience, and therefore build their resilience to examinations.

All subjects will assess students for the end-of-year report during the summer term with English and maths having a formal exam week, these will take place;

<b>Year 7 &amp; 8</b>	week beginning 3rd June for maths 5th June - All Year 7 & 8 Paper 1 6th June - Year 8 Paper 2 7th June Year 7 Paper 2 (The English exam was conducted last term; a letter was sent home)
<b>Year 9</b>	week beginning 1st July for maths and English
<b>Year 10 -</b>	week beginning 17th June, students will sit formal exams in all their subjects

Teachers will guide students in the lead-up to exams with access arrangements made available where appropriate.

Students will see how to create a revision planner, manage exam stress and will be able to discover different ways of revision.
