## Re: Uniform Expectations

With the winter term now well underway, I'm writing to you to remind students of our uniform expectations at Sandhurst School.

At Sandhurst School we expect all students to take pride in their appearance and to dress neatly. Except for a watch, one pair of plain gold or silver stud earrings and one discreet ring, jewellery can not be worn. Any type of facial piercing therefore is not permitted, including clear piercings. Fake nails and eyelashes are also not permitted.

Trainers and the "Airforce-One" style trainer/shoe hybrid footwear are not permitted at school. We would ask that proper shoes are purchased, shoes which are black, polishable and do not resemble trainers. Please see guidance in the attached appendix.

Students should currently come to school dressed in full winter uniform, this includes wearing their blazer. Hoodies are not allowed to be worn. We realise that purchasing uniform can be costly and we do have a store of nearly-new uniform which can be purchased at reduced prices. If your family is experiencing significant financial hardship prohibiting the purchase of new uniform, please contact your child's Head of House for assistance. If your child is not able to be in the correct uniform for a short period of time, then please can you provide a note.

No extremes of fashion are acceptable. It will be the school's final decision as to what is acceptable. If you are unsure about suitability of clothing for school, please contact the school before purchasing. Please see the appendix below on your uniform policy.

# School Uniform

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## Blazer

Navy blue with school badge

## Trousers

Students may wear long, tailored, plain trousers in dark grey, black or navy. Cord, cotton or denim trousers are not permitted. Leggings or skinny-style trousers are also forbidden.

## Skirt

Students may wear skirts which are pleated and dark navy. Skirts must be a sensible length, sitting just above or on the knee.

## Shirt

Students should wear EITHER a buttoned collar shirt with a school tie OR a shirt with a reverse collar without a tie. Shirts must be white and long enough to tuck into skirts or trousers. Shirts may be long or short sleeved.

## Tie

The school tie is navy and emerald. There is a senior tie of a different design which students in Year 10 and 11 may wear. If students choose to wear a buttoned collar shirt, they **MUST** wear a tie. Those students who choose to wear a shirt with a reverse collar are not required to wear a tie.

## Jumper (optional)

Plain, dark navy with emerald stripe at V-neck.

## Socks/Tights

Socks should be plain black, white, dark navy or dark grey.  
Tights are allowed providing they are plain, natural, navy or black.



## Shoes

Shoes must be smart, black, polishable and of a sensible height, with a maximum 1.5 inch heel. For example:



Trainers and the “Airforce-One”-style trainer/shoe hybrid footwear (see below for an example) are NOT permitted at school.



Boots, plimsols and pumps are also NOT permitted.

## Coats

All students should have a waterproof coat or jacket. Hoodies are not acceptable.

## Summer Polo Shirt (Optional from Easter to the end of September)

White polo shirt embroidered with the school and House logo.

## Jewellery

Students are only permitted to wear one discreet flat ring and one pair of stud earrings worn in the lower earlobe only. No other jewellery items are allowed.
