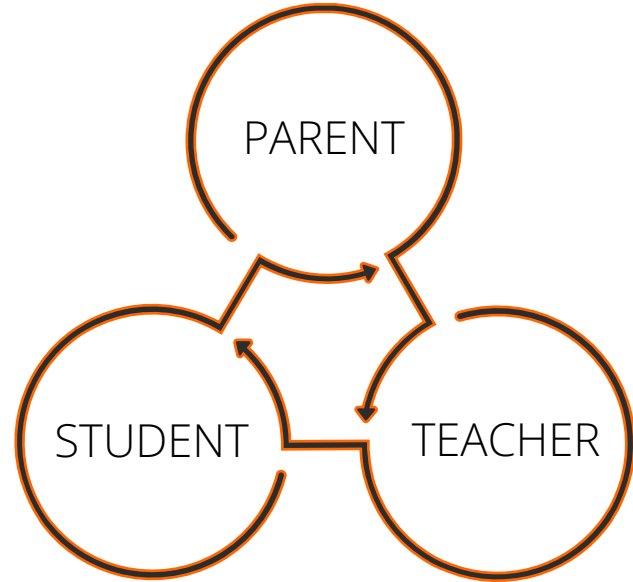

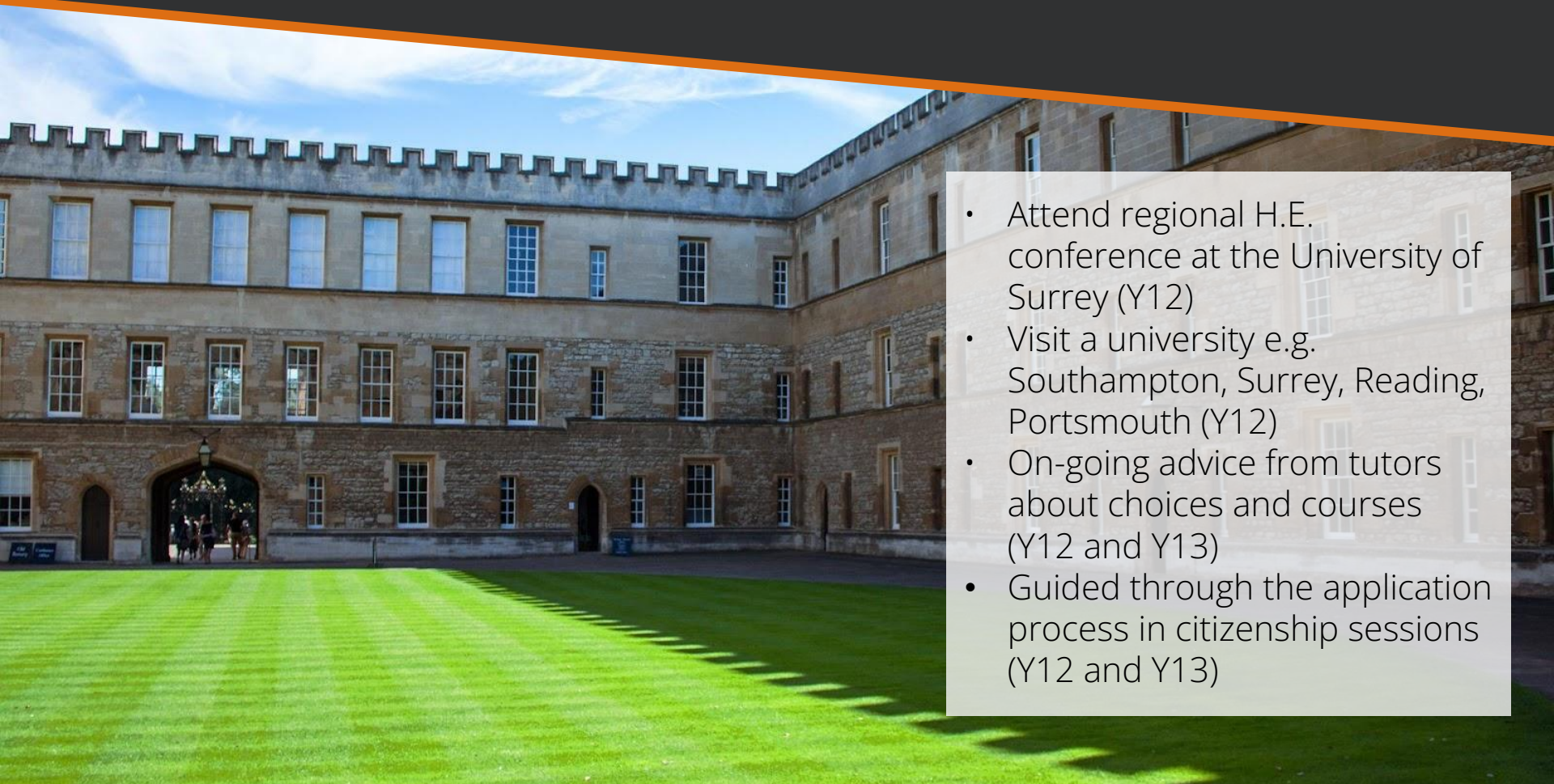
Example timetable of a full-time student in the Sixth Form

UNIVERSITY & HIGHER EDUCATION




- Attend regional H.E. conference at the University of Surrey (Y12)

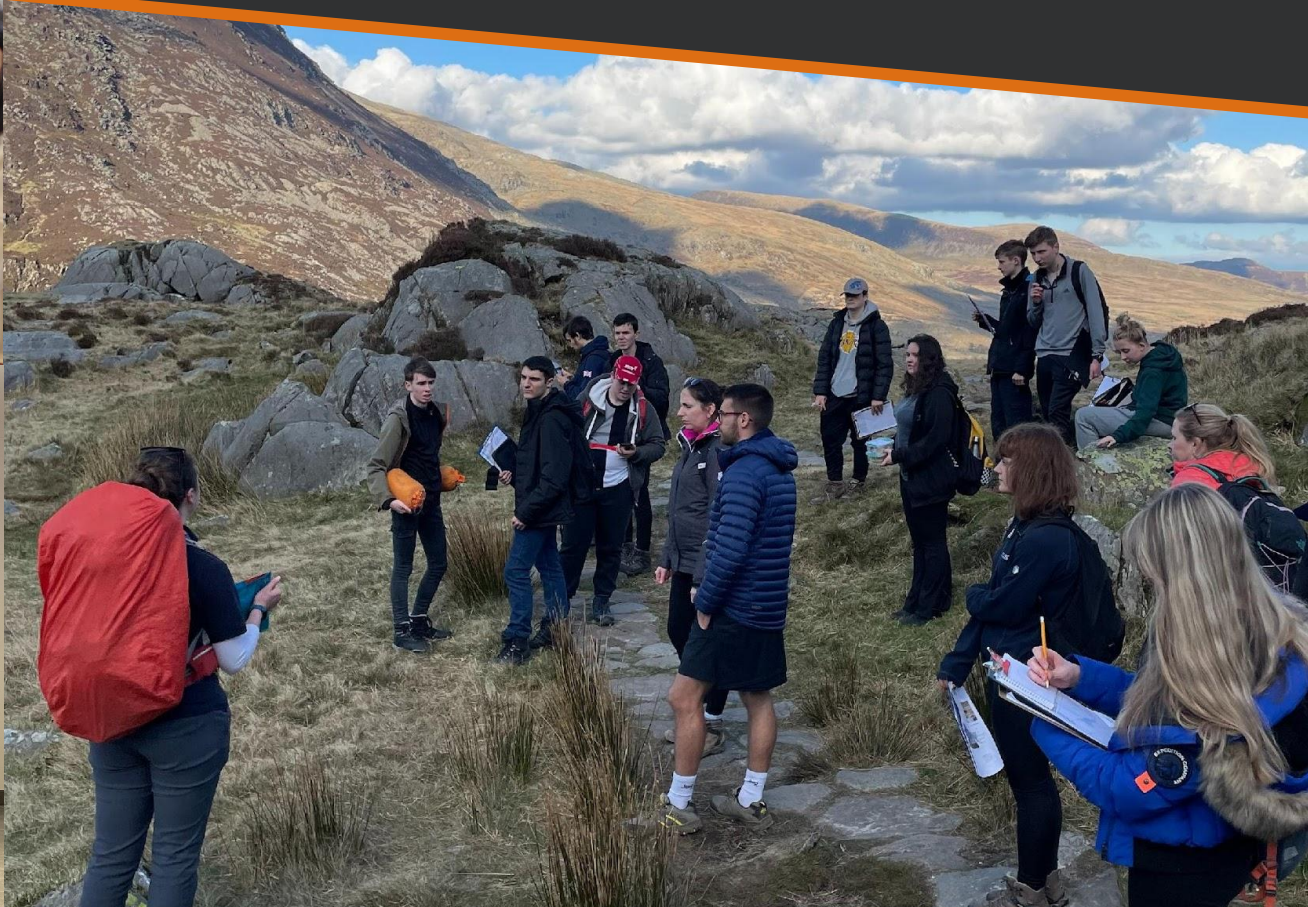

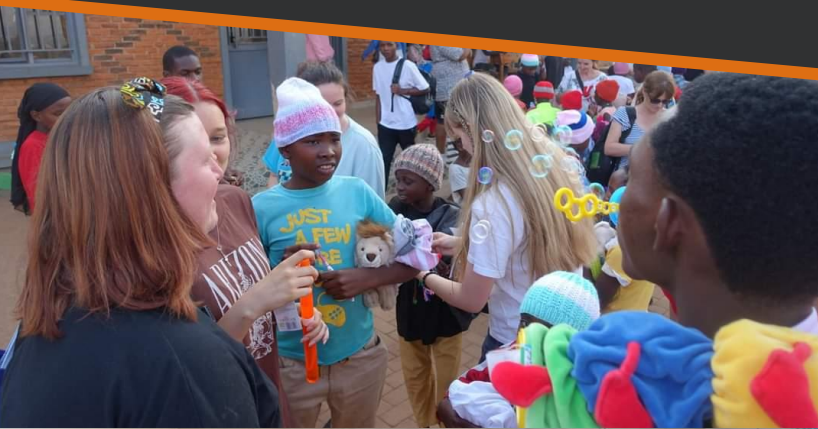
