Re: Summer Uniform

Students will be permitted to wear the optional summer uniform from the start of the summer term until the end of September 2023.

The optional summer uniform is a white polo shirt with the school name embroidered on it with your son's/daughter's house name and colour beneath it, and replaces the blazer, shirt and tie. If it is cold then students should wear a blazer and if necessary a school jumper with their polo shirt. Alternative jumpers or jackets are not acceptable.

Students who choose not to wear the summer uniform must wear their uniform as normal but will be permitted to remove blazers when the weather is hot, although the blazer should be brought to school.

The polo shirts are available from Brendas Schoolwear and are in stock now. You may order online for delivery or collection from the store, their website is www.brendas.co.uk. You may also telephone your order to Brendas and they can be contacted on 01276 818424.

At Sandhurst School we expect all students to take pride in their appearance and to dress neatly. Except for a watch, one pair of plain gold or silver stud earrings and one discreet ring, jewellery cannot be worn. Fake nails and eyelashes are also not permitted.

<p>Blazer</p> <p>Navy blue with school badge</p>
<p>Trousers</p> <p>Students may wear long, tailored, plain trousers in dark grey, black or navy. Cord, cotton or denim trousers are not permitted. Leggings or skinny-style trousers are also forbidden.</p>
<p>Skirt</p> <p>Students may wear skirts which are pleated and dark navy. Skirts must be a sensible length, sitting just above or on the knee.</p>
<p>Shirt</p> <p>Students should wear EITHER a buttoned collar shirt with a school tie OR a shirt with a reverse collar without a tie. Shirts must be white and long enough to tuck into skirts or trousers. Shirts may be long or short sleeved.</p>
<p>Tie</p> <p>The school tie is navy and emerald. There is a senior tie of a different design which students in Year 10 and 11 may wear. If students choose to wear a buttoned collar shirt, they MUST wear a tie. Those students who choose to wear a shirt with a reverse collar are not required to wear a tie.</p>
<p>Jumper (optional)</p> <p>Plain, dark navy with emerald stripe at V-neck.</p>
<p>Socks/Tights</p> <p>Socks should be plain black, white, dark navy or dark grey. Tights are allowed providing they are plain, natural, navy or black.</p>

Shoes

Shoes must be smart, black, polishable, sturdy, weatherproof and of a sensible height, with a maximum 1.5 inch heel. **No clear logo to be visible.** For example:



Boots, plimsolls, sliders and pumps are NOT permitted.

Coats

All students should have a waterproof coat or jacket. Hoodies are not acceptable.

Summer Polo Shirt (Optional from Easter to the end of September)

White polo shirt embroidered with the school and House logo.

Jewellery

Students are only permitted to wear one discreet flat ring and one pair of stud earrings worn in the lower earlobe only. No other jewellery items are allowed.
