## Re: Year 11 End of Year Arrangements 2024

This year's GCSE examinations will soon be upon us and both students and staff are making final preparations. Year 11 will shortly have their last assembly together providing an opportunity to look back with their Head of House at the journey they have been on.

We know many students will wish to sign shirts and leaver's books. Therefore, we have planned for students to use the **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May**, a charity non-uniform day for this. We suggest that students bring to school a spare shirt as non-written on shirts will still be needed after this date for school and exams.

Additionally, the year group will gather on the morning of the **Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> May** for Celebration of Success certificates to be awarded. This is when students are recognised for their outstanding contributions to the school and academic excellence.

As of the **Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> May**, students will start their home study leave. This means they will only be required to attend exams unless you request otherwise.

If you wish your son/daughter to revise at school (school study) then you will be required to complete the following online form. You can request for your son/daughter to be moved to home study at any point during the exam period. Students will not be allowed to swap back to school study.

## **Link to School Study Request Form**

If you have chosen for your son/daughter to **home study** then they must only be on the school site for their exams. If a **home study student** has an exam in the morning and also in the afternoon then they may attend their timetabled lessons between these exams but they must register with the reception following the morning exam so we know who is on the school site

If you have chosen for your son/daughter to **school study** then the following will apply.

- Subject revision will continue according to the normal lesson timetable until all the exams in that subject have been completed.
- Once the exam in a subject has been taken, these lessons will continue to be staffed by teachers so that students
  will be supervised whilst revising for other subjects. Students should bring the necessary work/notes/books with
  them.
- Students studying at school must register with their tutor during the morning registration period.
- This arrangement will continue until the completion of all your son/daughter's exams or you request home study for your son/daughter.

**Results day for Year 11 students is August 22**nd. Details of the day will be published on our website closer to the date. If your son/daughter cannot collect the results in person on the day, we will need written permission from your son/daughter to be able to send them out by post or release the results to another person.
